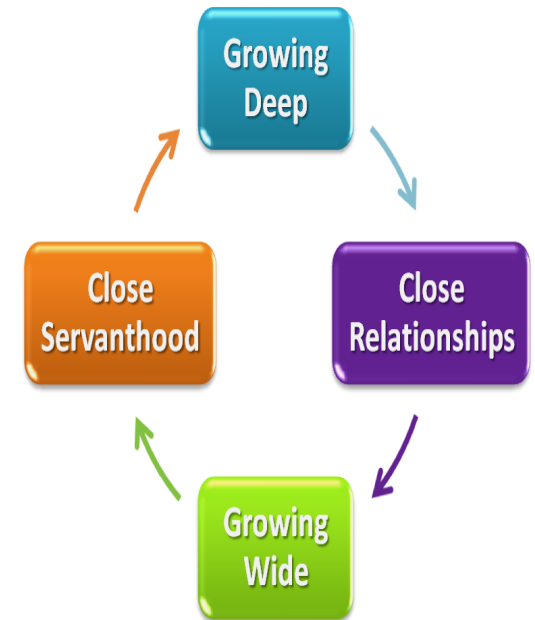

## Notice of Motion

We, the Deacon Board, move the following **amendment to the Constitution**, Article 5, Page 8 and Section E Ministry Team.

First, the portion "under the direction of the lead Pastor" be removed.

Secondly, the sentence "The Lead Pastor would act as the Chair of the Team and would act as the liaison between the Board of Governance and the Ministry Team." be replaced by: "A Chair will be nominated from the church body and will also become a member of the B.O.G. This person must not be a Chair of any Committee which is part of the Ministry Team."
